Have you completed 60 transferable units?

Meet with your current major advisor.

Discuss your transition to the IS3D major, and have your major advisor submit the 'Transitioning to IS3D' Form on your behalf.

Entering into the major

Fill out your [custom plan](#) using the guidelines for each discipline and send it to is3dadvising@sdsu.edu for pre-approval.

Once pre-approved, have all discipline areas sign a single custom plan document.

This means you email your custom plan to each advisor one advisor at a time. Once the first advisor signs it, you send it to the next advisor, and so on and so forth.

Submit your completed custom plan and attach a screenshot as proof of completion for your quiz to is3dadvising@sdsu.edu.
